International Baccalaureate student desired profile: the IB student...

- Is motivated and demonstrates intellectual energy and curiosity.
- Accepts challenges and demonstrates personal initiative.
- Is able to learn **independently**, while demonstrating strong interpersonal and co-operative skills essential to effective team building.
- Displays academic potential, has average to above average standing, and a broad range of academic and other interests.
- Displays a good command of spoken and written language and a commitment to second-language learning.
- Is **actively involved** in the extracurricular life of the school and the community and demonstrates a capacity and a willingness to assume a leadership role.
- Has a global perspective and demonstrates an appreciation and sensitivity to other cultures and perspectives.
- Accepts responsibility for their learning and actions

Rules and Policies specific to the Diploma Students

A Diploma student must:

- Adhere to the Rules of Conduct for students of Turner Fenton as laid out in the Student Agenda
- Successfully complete all prerequisite grade 11 IB courses prior to continuing to the Diploma HL level. (ex. SBI 3U8, SCH 3U8, ENG 3U8, FSF 3U8, MDM 4U9, CPW 4U8)
- Respect the Learner Profile and academic honesty (***Failure to abide by the rules for academic honesty will result in parents being contacted and may result in removal from the Programme***)
- Complete all IB assignments by the deadlines set by the teachers/coordinator
- Attend ALL classes regularly and on time until the May Exams begin
- Grade 11's: **one** day prior to the exam in May can be an authorized absence for studying – if the exam is a Monday, attendance on Friday is expected!. After completion of the exams Grade 11's are expected to attend **ALL** classes to which they are assigned.
Note: *persistent unauthorized absences will result in a conference with parents and may result in your being withdrawn from IB May exams with the consequence that June Ontario Exams will need to be written for credit.*
- Complete and submit on time, all Internal Assessments, the Extended Essay and TOK Essay. (***Failure to complete either the Extended Essay or the TOK Essay will result in loss of the IB Diploma and reduction to course certificate standing.***)
