International Baccalaureate student desired profile: the IB student...

- Is motivated and demonstrates intellectual energy and curiosity.
- Accepts challenges and demonstrates personal initiative.
- Is able to learn **independently**, while demonstrating strong interpersonal and co-operative skills essential to effective team building.
- Displays academic potential, has average to above average standing, and a broad range of academic and other interests.
- Displays an good command of spoken and written language and a commitment to second-language learning.
- Is **actively involved** in the extracurricular life of the school and the community and demonstrates a capacity and a willingness to assume a leadership role.
- Has a global perspective and demonstrates an appreciation and sensitivity to other cultures and perspectives.
- Accepts responsibility for their learning and actions

Rules and policies specific to the MYP student

An MYP student must:

- Adhere to the Rules of Conduct for students of Turner Fenton as laid out in the Student Agenda
- Complete all IB assignments for the deadlines set by the teachers
- Respect the Learner Profile and academic honesty. *(Failure to abide by the rules for academic honesty will result in parents being contacted and may result in removal from the Programme).*
- Attend all classes regularly and on time. *(persistent unauthorized absences or late arrival will result in a conference with parents and may result in removal from the MYP programme)*
- Participate in the Personal Project to its **successful** completion, including the **Demonstration** in late November/early December and the **Report**. *(Failure to successfully complete either part of the Personal Project, which is an IB requirement for recognition of the MYP will result in a student's being removed from the program at the end of Grade 10 and may necessitate leaving Turner Fenton for the Home School)*
